



January Book Report/2nd Grade Famous WAX MUSEUM Due Friday January 28, 2022

This month the children will be reading a BIOGRAPHY or AUTOBIOGRAPHY. Either choice will be acceptable. A biography is a factual book written about a real person by another person. An autobiography is a factual book written about a person by that person. Please help your child choose a book that is both age appropriate and at their individual reading level.

Some examples of past book reports have been on **Abraham Lincoln, Jim Carrey, J.K. Rowlings, Sacagawea, & Laura Ingalls Wilder**. Unlike past book reports, the only written parts of the book reports will be the notes that each child makes for themselves.

Directions:

1. Children will come to school on January 28th
2. dressed as their person with their poster
3. Children will perform as the person they read about dressed in the appropriate costume.
4. Children will give facts about their "self" in a 30 second presentation that is memorized (you can use a 3x5 card to help that is okay)
 - a. Birth and Childhood
 - b. Education
 - c. Life as an Adult
 - d. Accomplishments or Recognitions
 - e. Interesting Facts
 - f. Death (if applicable)
 - g. Accomplishments or Recognitions after death
5. Children will need to make a poster with a hand drawn picture of their person and the facts above posted.
6. Children will be performing in front of invited guests as a "WAX MUSEUM"
