

## January Book Report/2<sup>nd</sup> Grade Famous WAX MUSEUM Due Friday January 28, 2022

This month the children will be reading a BIOGRAPHY or AUTOBIOGRAPHY. Either choice will be acceptable. A biography is a factual book written about a real person by another person. An autobiography is a factual book written about a person by that person. Please help your child choose a book that is both age appropriate and at their individual reading level.

Some examples of past book reports have been on **Abraham Lincoln**, **Jim Carrey**, **J.K. Rowlings**, **Sacagawea**, **& Laura Ingalls Wilder**. Unlike past book reports, the only written parts of the book reports will be the notes that each child makes for themselves.

## Directions:

- 1. Children will come to school on January28th
- 2. dressed as their person with their poster
- 3. Children will perform as the person they read about dressed in the appropriate costume.
- 4. Children will give facts about their "self" in a 30 second presentation that is memorized (you can use a 3x5 card to help that is okay)
  - a. Birth and Childhood
  - b. Education
  - c. Life as an Adult
  - d. Accomplishments or Recognitions
  - e. Interesting Facts
  - f. Death (if applicable)
  - g. Accomplishments or Recognitions after death
- 5. Children will need to make a poster with a hand drawn picture of their person and the facts above posted.
- 6. Children will be performing in front of invited guests as a "WAX MUSEUM"
- 7. Date for Book Report is due on Friday January 28th
- 8. This is a pass or fails book report. There are no makeups for this book report.
